MINOR:	Open to any registered member of the Welsh Chess Union or other National Body with a published national rating of 1430 (ECF 100) or below.

- RATE OF PLAY:** All moves in 90 minutes, with 30 seconds increment for each move starting from move 1.
- BYES:** Competitors may claim a half point bye in any of the first four rounds. All first round byes must be claimed at the time of entry.
- WITHDRAWALS:** Regrettably, refunds will not be considered until the cost of overheads are met.
- EXCLUSIONS / TRANSFERS:** The organisers reserve the right to refuse or transfer entries
- LATE ARRIVALS:** All competitors will be allowed 30 minutes on their clocks in any round and then defaulted
- APPEALS** Any appeal against an Arbiter's decision will be subject to a formal appeals procedure, to be detailed at the event
