# Match Secretary's Report 2011

## League Divisional winners

41 teams competed in our Four Divisions last season. This compares to 39 teams last season in 2009 2010.

**Division 1** Clifton A won by an impressive margin of 8 pts between them and  $2^{nd}$  place Downend A. Five teams were in the running for  $2^{nd}$  place until the final week of the season. At the bottom of the table Clevedon A struggled after losing key players from last season.

**Division 2** was won convincingly by University A by the same margin 8pts! The University only dropping 4 pts all season. Grendel finished in second spot and will be looking forward to a return to Division One. Keynsham A and Bath University finished in the bottom two places.

**Division 3** Cabot won the Division Three title by the smallest of margins after finishing only half a game point ahead of South Bristol. Harambee & Hanham B finished in the bottom two places.

**Division 4** 12 teams competed in the bottom division and unfortunately this was reduced to 11 teams by Christmas as the UWE were unable play the remainder of their games. Thornbury B & Horfield D fought it out for top spot in a very competitive division. Thornury B emerging as winners in the last week of the season.

### **Knockout winners**

**LKO** – Clifton played Bath in the final of the League Knockout – a repeat of last season's clash. The eight board match didn't disappoint as the last four boards were decided with only minutes left on the clock. Clifton emerging as winners 5- 3 in the end.

**MLKO** – Clifton wrapped up the Minor Knockout with a convincing 5.5 - 0.5 win over Hanham in the final.
