Entries were significantly up at the 51st Cotswold Chess Congress, which took place on 25th-27th May at the King's School, Gloucester, located in the shadow of the city's magnificent cathedral. A total of 96 players took part in the six-round Swiss. For the first time, the Open incorporated the Gloucestershire County Individual Championship, which was awarded to the highest-placed eligible player.
